## ISIS COURT CARE APARTMENTS DONNINGTON, OXFORD

The Isis Care and Retirement Centre located in the popular area of Iffley is a state of the art, purpose-designed group of facilities for older people, developed in partnership with Oxfordshire County Council, Oxford City Council, The Orders of St John Care Trust and bpha. Isis Court comprises 20 "Extra Care" sheltered housing units with on-site care services. The Centre also includes Isis House, a care home supporting 60 nursing clients and 20 residential beds (See separate leaflet)



"Extra Care" offers flexible care and support, a safe environment and rights and control to people in their own home, with the back-up of 24 hour support from housing, social care and health care teams. It can provide access to meals, domestic support, leisure and recreational facilities. Older people are able to live independently, in their "extra care" homes, whilst taking advantage of a range of facilities and support.

Within the apartments, an en-suite shower room is accessible from both the hall and bedroom. The kitchen is conveniently situated off the spacious, light and airy lounge.

The main areas of activity within the Centre include the bar, the hairdressing salon, the internet café and most especially the dance floor. A shop allows residents to purchase small items for personal care, confectionery, and daily papers.

The Care Centre is conveniently located close to shopping amenities, a chemist and is on a bus route to the city centre. A short walk from the well designed grounds takes you to the river and the charming village of Iffley.

Being purpose-designed and built, the Centre can meet the needs of the less able by providing lifts to all floors, level floors, hard paved garden area and hand rails along all corridors. All doors are wide enough for wheelchair access and hand rails provide extra security in the bathrooms and toilets.

The Orders of St John Care Trust ensures all staff are friendly, well trained, experienced and committed to providing the best care possible in order to enrich the experience of the residents in their care. The Care Centre employs a full time activities

co-ordinator who provides an interesting and stimulating choice of events and social activities. Smaller craft sessions and group work complement the large scale social occasions making sure that tenants/residents are certain to find something to their liking, adding to the quality of experience gained by living in such a Care Centre.

Local links to the community are encouraged, with relationships with the local churches plus a strong group of volunteers adding support and further opportunities to meet people and create friendships.

Other services available include visits from chiropodists, opticians and art therapists and personal hairdressers may continue to visit using the well equipped therapy room and hairdressing salon.

To access these apartments you will have a care need that has been identified by the local Social Services department (Oxfordshire County Council) and a housing need as identified by the Oxford City Council Housing Department. There will be a rent and service charge for all tenants plus a care charge, although help with benefit advice will be provided. In the first instance please contact the General Manager of the Care Centre who will be able to provide advice and support you through these processes.
